Tribute to Philip Morsberger



Philip Morsberger – the painter whose art led viewers into a world of color expressing both the comic and the profound – died Sunday, January 3, 2021 from COVID-19 complications. He was 87. Morsberger had lived in Augusta since 1996 when he became the William S. Morris Eminent Scholar in Art at Augusta University. He held the endowed professorship until 2001.

"Augusta and America have lost a giant among artists," said Morris, who founded the city's Morris Museum of Art, in which Morsberger's works ranked among the most popular with visitors. "His gifts to the community are numerous, but perhaps the greatest of them was his presence and the shining example he provided of the creative life," Morris said. Kevin Grogan, director of the Morris Museum, said perhaps Morsberger's greatest gift was his vast capacity for friendship.

"No one enjoyed friendship more than Philip, and no one ever made and kept as many friends as he. He found commonality with, well, everyone," Grogan said. "His kindness and generosity of spirit were innate and unsurpassable, and it is those qualities that touched generations of students, countless colleagues, and numberless friends over the length of a long life well-lived." Grogan called Morsberger's many interests "protean and encompassing," spanning the novels of Charles Dickens and the film scores of Alfred Newman. Old movies, 1930s radio dramas and classic newspaper comic strips "fired his imagination and fed his artistry," Grogan said.

Sandra Rupp, whose Hampton III Gallery in Greenville, S.C., represented Morsberger for more than 20 years, said that "he helped us all see what we could not. By opening his life, he revealed our own. Sometimes quirky, other times funny and sometimes sad, he took us to a better place through his art."

A committed realist painter early in his career, Morsberger captured the tumultuous politics of the 1960s in many pop-influenced works. But in the 1970s, he moved toward the abstract, developing a distinctive style in which he would use canvases bursting with color to conjure images from his past, such as the cartoons that captivated his imagination as a boy. Born in Baltimore in 1933, Morsberger discovered art with his grandfather, who would pencil changes in daily newspapers' illustrations, and became the boy's first art teacher. He began formal study at the Maryland Institute College of Art as a scholarship student in 1946, when he was just 13. Morsberger continued his studies at La Grande Chaumiere in Paris; the Carnegie Institute of Technology, the alma mater of Andy Warhol; and at England's Oxford University.

From 1971 to 1984, Morsberger returned to Oxford as the Ruskin Master of Drawing at the university's Ruskin School of Art – the first American to attain the mastership. During his tenure, the school moved to its current High Street location, and in 1984 awarded its first Oxford degrees in fine art.

Beginning in the early 1960s, Morsberger held several influential teaching positions at schools in the United States and England, including at Harvard University, Dartmouth College and the University of California at Berkeley. After retiring from his post as the President's Fellow in Painting at the California College of Arts and Crafts, he moved to Augusta.

Getting Started

- Enter **https://rsabid.com** into your browser's address field (not the search field), then enter this 5-digit Event Code when prompted: **30901**. Log in.
- Once logged in, you'll remain so for 24 hours unless you share your account. If you share your account with a spouse or partner who logs in on a different device, you'll be logged out and will need to log back in to bid.

Bidding



- *Standard Bid*: Entered amount becomes your current bid.
-  *Otto-Assisted (Max) Bid*: Otto™ the Bidding Robot automatically bids for you up to the limit you specify.
- *Win It Now*: If you're the first to click this button, you win!

Search

- To search by catalog number, enter: **# + catalog number** into the search field. For example, type: #123
- To search by fewest bids, use the **Show Least Bids First** filter. It's found on the home page and at the top of each item list in the eCatalog.

Outbid
