An Augusta, GA native, Russell Joel Brown is a graduate of Morehouse College. He has appeared on Broadway, in Taiwan, and on the 1st National and 2nd National Tours of Disney's "The Lion King"; the 1st National Tours of "The Scarlet Pimpernel", and "Smokey Joe's Café", the Japanese Tour of "Smokey Joe's Cafe", and a European Tour of "Ain't Musbehavin". As a bass soloist at New York's famed Cathedral of St. John the Divine, he sang for the state funerals of Dizzy Gillespie, Arthur Ashe, Cab Calloway, and Thurgood Marshall. Mr. Brown also won the "Best Actor in a Musical" award from the Connecticut Critics' Circle for his work as Jim in "Big River" at Goodspeed Opera House.

As creator, producer, and principal talent, Mr. Brown developed "From Mozart to Motown: An Evening with Russell Joel Brown". This full-scale, theatrical, one-man show featured 15 local-area high school students in the production, and sold out Augusta's 900-seat Imperial Theater 5 times. In 2014, he developed "Russell Joel Brown's Project: Inspire", an outreach program for middle and high school students, which was presented in over 280 schools from 2014 - 2018. It encourages children to strive for excellence and explore their creativity, using the theater arts as a conduit for more general applications.

Today, Mr. Brown combines his love for the theater and his love for children, accepting speaking engagements and master class invitations at schools and camps around the country.



In 2017, Mr. Brown retired from show business, returning to his native Augusta to launch a major project for the city's children.

The Academy for Boys is slated to open in Fall, 2021 with 72 scholars in 4 Kindergarten classes of 18 each, and adding a Grade level every year. Our students in the first 6 years will attend the regular school day and our after-school enrichment programs, and return to their family homes. In our 7<sup>th</sup> year, our first year of boarding, all 6<sup>th</sup> Graders will begin the school year as full-time residents of the Russell Joel Brown Academy for Boys. They will live on-campus Monday through Friday, and return to their families on the weekends.



"From Mozart to Motown- An Evening with Russell Joel Brown" is a high-energy, tour de force performance by Broadway actor and Augusta native, Russell Joel Brown. Backed by a 7-piece band and 15-member high school student ensemble, this performance features 10 different styles of music: classical, spirituals, Broadway, jazz, blues, country, African, R & B, rock, and gospel. The newly restored and prestigious Miller Theater is the proud location of "From Mozart to Motown" in 2020.



Mozart to Motown 2020 with Russell Joel Brown will be showcased in Spring 2020 at the Miller Theater.

In the past, the five sold-out audiences at Augusta's historic Imperial Theater (between 2002 and 2004) solidified the popularity of this show.

Production numbers, with sizzling choreography and beautiful costumes round out the evening, ending with a Motown celebration.

### **About Jessye Norman**

Jessye Norman, who was educated at Augusta's C.T. Walker Elementary, A.R. Johnson Junior High, and Lucy Laney High Schools, has been a legend who proved that African-Americans could play lead roles in opera on the great stages of the world!

The world embraced Jessye Norman with arms open wide. After graduating from Howard University in Washington, DC, and completing graduate studies at Peabody Conservatory of Music and University of Michigan, she set out for Europe where she found great success. She is best known for interpreting Richard Wagner's operas and German lieder of various composers. Not surprisingly, she has been honored with every award imaginable, from the coveted Kennedy Center Honor (the youngest ever to have received that award); numerous Grammy awards, including a Lifetime Achievement Award; the NAACP Spingarn Award; France's highest merit award the Legion of Honor; America's highest honor awarded to artists- the National Medal of Arts; and countless honorary doctorates from prestigious universities.

#### School Overview:

The Russell Joel Brown Academy for Boys - A Project of The Russell Joel Brown Foundation, 501(c)(3)

The Russell Joel Brown Academy for Boys will be a Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade boarding school for boys in Augusta, GA. Operating in the 30901 zip code of Richmond County, it will feature a STEAM curriculum (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math), with enrichment programming in leadership, etiquette, elocution, and service to the world community.

We will seek a charter from the Georgia State Charter Schools Commission, which should cover our daily costs for education. Other funding for the enrichment and boarding costs will come from private donations, foundation support, and grants.

Our school will be a traditional day school for the K through 5<sup>th</sup> Graders. Beginning at the 6<sup>th</sup> Grade level, all students will board on the school grounds. All meals, lodging, and recreation will be provided by the Academy for Boys, as well as tutoring, counseling, and mentoring.
